- 1. Coin toss determines who has first possession in the game. Team who loses coin toss will receive possession to start the second half.
- 2. Each player shall play a minimum of half (50%) of the total playing time each game.
- 3. Players must wear tennis shoes or soft-cleated soccer shoes. Jewelry is not allowed.
- 4. If a team cannot field the minimum, both coaches along with the facility supervisor can agree to change the player minimum for that game.
- 5. Misconduct will not be tolerated. The referee and/or coach will explain all infringements to the offending player.
- 6. Coaches can choose to rest players as needed, however, a co-ed atmosphere must be maintained on the field at all times.
- 7. K-4th Grade: In the event of an illegal throw-in, the player who threw it in will get a warning and one re-throw to throw it in legally. If that player still throws the ball in illegally, the ball is dead and it is given to the opposing team to throw in.
- 8. Score will not be kept in any division.
- 9. The clock will run continuously throughout the game. There will be no stoppage time.
- 10. Each team will have 1 time out per half. Each time out will be 1 minute in length.
- 11. K-8th Grade: Free, corner, goal, and penalty kicks will be awarded.
- 12. Any rule not covered in these rules, and not covered by the United States Youth Soccer Association, will be left to the discretion of the ORC.
